POP RESEARCH FACTS

Every sample POP has ever processed (200+) from various sources (ie. dolphin digestive tracts, animal scat, marine and freshwater, beach sediment, etc.) has contained microplastics.

Polyethylene (PE) and polyethylene terephthalate (PET) were the most commonly found plastics from water samples collected from the Neuse River. PE is found in food packaging while PET is used in fabrics such as clothing, upholstery, and carpeting.

Some solutions to plastic pollution are arising in the form of innovative technology, like seabins and trash trouts, surface marine debris collectors.

Sea turtle nest sediments from 2020 contained microfibers made of PET, Acrylic, and Nylon

In spring of 2022, trash collection data from Wrightsville Beach determined access #3 and access #43 had the highest amount of litter. The most prevalent material being Styrofoam

Plastic Ocean Project teamed up with Wrightsville Beach Keep It Clean and Keep Brunswick County Beautiful in 2015 to establish the Ocean Friendly Establishments (OFE) initiative. The program uses a 5-star rating system to recognize additional oceanfriendly efforts including offering compostable to-go containers and reusable condiment bowls. Over 200 establishments have earned their 5-star OFE! What began in the Wilmington-Wrightsville Beach area has spread throughout southeastern North Carolina and all the way to Oregon!

- Provide non-plastic recyclable and/or biodegradable to-go food/beverage containers, cutlery, and bags.
- Provide reusable cutlery, dishware/ramekins for onsite dining.
